

# **Primary One Revision Guide**

## **Numeracy**

### **Numbers to 10**

Count to 10 and backwards.

Count groups of objects up to 10.

Identify a number 1 more/ 1 less.

Identify a number 2 more/2 less.

Identify the larger/smaller number from a pair

Identify the largest/smallest number from a group of 3 or 4.

Sequence your number cards from 0-10.

Start learning the number names from your number names cards and match these to the digit cards.

### **Numbers to 20**

Count to 20 and backwards.

Count groups of objects up to 20.

Identify a number 1 more/ 1 less.

Identify a number 2 more/2 less.

Identify the larger/smaller number from a pair

Identify the largest/smallest number from a group of 3 or 4.

Sequence your number cards from 0-10.

Start learning the number names from your number names cards and match these to the digit cards.

### **Addition to 10**

Use objects to add groups together to find a total

Learn the stories (all the ways to add up to a number) to 10.

Practise missing number sums for example 2 add what makes 4?

### **Pattern**

Create simple patterns using 2 or 3 repeating shapes.

Create simple patterns with colours e.g. red blue red blue

## **Shape**

Revise 2d shape names and properties.

Square, circle, triangle, rectangle.

Identify these 2d shapes in your home.

Answer questions such as how many sides does a square have?

Extend this to learning the names of 3d shapes including: cube, cuboid, cylinder, sphere, cone.

Identify these in your surroundings.

## **Time**

Practise days of the week songs.

What is the date today? What month are we in?

What season are we in?

Describe some features of each season.

Tell the time to o'clock.
