Literacy (See Education City 'Room 10')

Reading

Read, read, read! Read any books you already have or new ones if you can and then talk about them.

Discuss tricky words, ask for help if you need to. When you start a new book think about predictions, what do you think will happen? Why? What do you like about the book? What would you have done differently? Who was your favourite character? Why? What about the plot? Did you think it was good? Could you create a new ending?

However, most importantly read for fun and enjoy your books.

Spelling

Your spelling lists are attached so use this time to revise everything you have learned so far. Use your own strategies e.g. rainbow writing, pyramids or creating your own wordsearch or crossword puzzle.

Writing

Write about anything! Write about what you have been doing or even a Newspaper Report, remember the 5 W's: Who, What, Where, When & Why. Don't forget the attention-grabbing headline, informative opening paragraph, chronological order of events, concluding paragraph and pictures with appropriate captions.

You could practice Narrative Writing, use your imagination. Try to include your targets: a detailed opening, describe the atmosphere, setting and main characters, describe the main events in a sequenced order, include dialogue, a turning point or cliff-hanger which brings your piece of writing to a satisfactory conclusion.

Remember Punctuation, full stops and capital letter in the correct places! Try to include similes, metaphors, alliteration, adjectives, powerful verbs, interesting sentence openers, adverbs, WOW words. 😊
