Homework

Your child's teacher will continue to communicate with your child's class through their Google Classroom for weekly homework.

Jotters sent home for children to complete any written tasks should not be returned to school and should remain at home.

If required, please support your child to access their Google Classroom and complete their homework tasks.

Please encourage your child to respond to questions and upload their homework by themselves, where possible.

Learning from home due to individual self-isolation

In the event of your child being asked to self-isolate, we will continue to use Google Classroom to communicate and set learning tasks for children. A number of tasks will be issued for your child to complete each day. These will include a daily literacy task, numeracy task and a Health and Wellbeing task, where appropriate.

Your child's class teacher can answer questions through Google Classroom/email, but please remember they are still in class so responses will not be instant.

Please encourage your child to respond to questions and upload their home learning tasks by themselves, where possible.



Learning from home due to class self-isolation/school closure

In the event of your child's class being asked to isolate or requiring to learn from home, we will also use Google Classroom to communicate and set learning tasks for children. These will include a daily literacy task, numeracy task and a Health and Wellbeing task, where appropriate.

Where possible, your child will be asked to be online at 9am to check in for the day. The class teacher is able to facilitate an online register to track engagement. The children will be shown how to do this.

In the event of Learning from Home continuing for a prolonged period of time, some extended tasks may be shared and your child will be given a number of days to complete them. If this is the case, specific instructions will be shared by your child's class teacher.

Please encourage your child to respond to questions and upload their home learning tasks by themselves, where possible.

Your child's class teacher will arrange specific times when they will be online to support their learning/answer any specific questions.
