

#### Participatory Budget – Parent/Carer Volunteers Required!

A letter was sent out to families via ParentPay asking for parent/carer volunteers to become part of a new Participatory Budget Working Group. This group will work closely with the school to help identify innovative ways of spending 5% of our Pupil Equity Funding which is used to close the poverty-related attainment gap. # Promoting Positive Relationships: Guidance for Families

On 24<sup>th</sup> August, we shared our updated Promoting Positive Behaviour Guidance for Families on our School App. This is based on the principles of Attachment Theory and The Solihull Approach. The guidance document outlines our 'On Track/Off Track' system for managing behaviour and the introduction of 'Reflection Time', a short restorative and solution-focused activity, for anyone whose behaviour is 'Off Track'. We will continue to encourage and recognise positive behaviours by celebrating pupils/classes who demonstrate a commitment to our School Values. Our previous 'weekly certificates' will no longer be used, instead we will be aiming to recognise more pupils over the course of the year through a new 'Values in Action' approach and 'Celebrating Success Ceremony'. More information regarding this will be shared with families soon.

We would be grateful if all families could familiarise themselves with the Promoting Positive Relationships Guidance to ensure consistency and to enable us to work together.



# Liaison Time

We are extremely lucky at Udston to have a brilliant team of teaching and support staff who work really hard to ensure the best possible outcomes for our children. To enable class teachers and support staff to work together as effectively as possible, we have introduced 30 minutes of 'Liaison Time' per week where the teacher and support staff member meet to discuss the learning focuses for the week ahead. During this time, a member of SLT or the CCC teacher goes into class to deliver a lesson on one of our School Values. This week, we have been focusing on 'Trust', what this means and what it looks like in action. We have asked pupils to become 'Trust Detectives' and try to notice examples of 'Trust' at home and in school. Please chat to your child about this as it really helps reinforce the importance of our School Values. Thank you!
